



Port Moller Test Fish Catch Update

Catch Update #3, June 12, 2026

Good evening,

Light catches again today.

We had to skip Stations 2 and 4 today in order to pick up crew from Port Moller. Wind and wave forecasts show conditions may deteriorate around midmorning tomorrow, but the vessels should still be able to cover a good portion of the transect.

We'll include the usual catch update table and raw data in the next few days. We'd like to sample at least one or two more days before interpolating catch indices for missed stations.

PMTF Stock Composition Status: Tomorrow the boats will fish toward each other and meet up in the evening. With luck, we'll have enough genetics samples for the first stock composition of the year. Although, with the last two days producing only 2 and 45 sockeye, we may fall short.
