Good evening,

The Daily Catch Index fell today after holding more or less steady for the past five days, with catches continuing to shift inshore over the last four. It is too early to say whether the lighter index reflects a subsiding migration rate, and we don't yet know what the shift in catch pattern means. Historically, the highest average catch day at Port Moller is June 29, so a few more days of test fishing indices and C+E should help narrow the range of scenarios.

PMTF Stock Composition Status: The stock composition for June 26–27 should be released June 28 or 29.
