Good evening,

Rough weather today prevented sets at the outer stations. The vessels plan to steam toward each other tomorrow, with improved conditions in the forecast; however, the R/V *St. Andrew* may get a late start as it waits for seas to lay down.

The Daily Catch Index remained strong, bolstered by a solid catch at Station 8 (Link 1 above). So far, the 2025 pattern appears to blend elements of the 2021, 2022, and 2023 seasons (Link 3).

Current travel time estimates from the test fishery to the districts are as follows: Ugashik-8.6 days, Egegik-9.2, Naknek-Kvichak-11.2, and Nushagak-8.3. If these travel time estimates are correct, the Kvichak District should see a much stronger showing by July 2 with a Bay-wide substantial increase expected by July 3 (see Link 4 to facilitate translation of PMTF indices into catch and escapement).

The *St. Andrew* also fished Station 26 yesterday evening, which produced a catch index of 31.

PMTF Stock Composition Status: Genetic samples for the 8th stock composition (June 29, 30 and July 1) will be transferred between vessels tomorrow evening, which will likely be late. While this stock composition could be released on July 2 (Wednesday), weather and timing may delay this until July 3.
