High catch indices again today across the inshore stations; goose eggs for the outer ones. There's still nothing to indicate that a 40-45 million run with near-average timing is drastically off.

Thank you for the feedback on yesterday's question. There's a lot of experience out there, and sometimes the better ideas are born out of a two-way conversation between scientists and user groups. Apologies for not responding to everyone individually, but the overarching theme across all the responses was the same. Yes, we've looked at sea temperature, wind, tide, and current from various angles for years. We know that some combination of these variables, at the right scale, would likely explain the outcomes we see. Sometimes data doesn't listen, though. For now, we'll keep working to increase its quantity and quality.
