



Port Moller Test Fish Catch Update

Good evening,

Today, catches continued to increase at Stations 6–10, while Stations 12 and beyond remained light. Compared to recent years (see link above), current catches are similar to those observed in 2021 and 2022, both notably large runs of 68 and 79 million fish, which were one and two days late, respectively. This year's preseason forecast is approximately 52 million fish. Based on early indications from the test fishery, the most likely scenario suggests the run is either slightly early to on time or potentially larger than forecasted.

PMTF Stock Composition Status: The two vessels will meet tomorrow evening and exchange samples to begin work on the 2nd stock composition. Weather will be the primary determinant of when these results are released.
